PMI Credentialing

- Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM)
- Project Management Professional (PMP)
- Program Managers (New)



Educate - PMI

CAPM

- Who's Eligible – Professionals from all disciplines
- Eligibility Criteria
 - High School Grad or Equivalent
 - 1500 Hours of Work on a Project Team
 - Or 23 Hours of Formal Project Management Education
- Cost – Electronic - Non-members \$300/Members \$225



Educate - PMI

PMP

- Who's Eligible – Professionals who meet specific requirements
- Eligibility Criteria:
 - High School Grad or Equivalent
 - 7500 leading specific tasks & 60 months of Project Management Experience or 4500 hours, if have Bachelors Degree
 - 35 Hours of Project Management Education
- Cost – Electronic- Non-Member \$555/Member \$405



Educate - PMI

Program Manager (New)

- Who's Eligible – Professionals who lead the coordinated management of multiple projects.
- Eligibility Criteria:
 - Specific Criteria pending final approval
- Cost: (New ?)



Educate – American Society for the Advancement of Project Management (ASAPM)

Certified Senior Project Manager (CSPM)

- Who's Eligible – Professionals who have managed complex projects.
- Eligibility Criteria:
 - High School Grad or Equivalent
- Course Requirements – 2 Stages
- Cost - \$2070 to \$2375



Educate – George Washington University – ESI International

Masters Certificate in Project Management

- Who's Eligible: Professionals from all disciplines
- Eligibility Criteria
 - High School Grad or Equivalent
- Course Requirements – 7 courses
- Cost - \$10,000 to \$13,000



Educate – George Washington University

Masters of Science in Project Management

- Who's Eligible – Professionals who meet specific requirements
- Eligibility Criteria:
 - High School Grad or Equivalent
 - Bachelors
- Course Requirements – 13 courses (classroom or online)
- Cost - \$34,956
